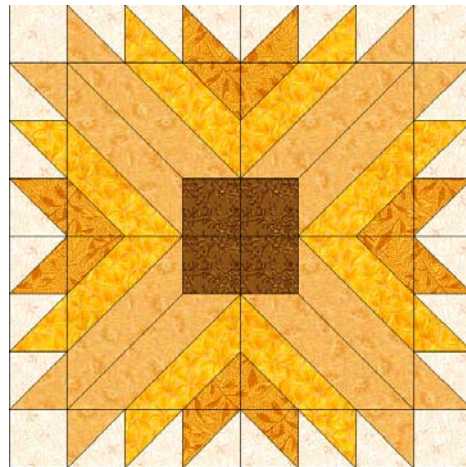


Flower Sampler:

Block of the Month for February 2006

Block 3: Chrysanthemum

Cut:	Background Fabric:	Cut 12 – 2 ½" squares then cut on the diagonal Cut 4 – 2" squares
	Colour A:	Cut 4 – 2 ½" squares, then cut on the diagonal. Sew these to background triangles on the diagonal and then trim to 2"
	Colour B:	Cut 4 2- 2 ½" squares and cut on the diagonal. Sew these to the background triangles on the diagonal and trim to 2".
	Colour C:	Cut 4 – 2 ½" squares and repeat as A & B on background and trim to 2"



Piecing: Cut these strips using the template below making sure to add ¼" on all sides and that ½ the strips are done in reverse. D being the centre of the completed block. Make 4 of these blocks and join into a 4 patch.

Sew D to C x 8

Sew A to B to C, then using the reverse strips repeat the process. Trim to 5".

Sew the triangles A, B & C to the background triangles. Sew to block matching colours.

Sew triangles A, B & C to the background triangles and 2" background square. Sew to block.
